NO INSURANCE NEEDED

Being short on cash shouldn't mean being short on insulin.

The Minnesota Insulin Safety Net Program was created to help Minnesotans who face difficulty affording their insulin. This life-saving program is made up of two parts: the urgent need program and the continuing need program.

- URGENT NEED PROGRAM Eligible Minnesotans can receive a 30day supply of insulin immediately at their pharmacy for no more than \$35.
- CONTINUING NEED PROGRAM Eligible Minnesotans can receive up to a year supply of insulin for no more than \$50 per 90-day refill. Visit MNinsulin.org for more information on getting help to apply.

FILL OUT AN APPLICATION

Complete the application form at mninsulin.org. Just open the file and follow the instructions. If you are not able to access or print this form, please ask your pharmacist for the "urgent need insulin application."



TAKE IT TO YOUR PHARMACY

Take your completed application form to your pharmacy with valid identification and insulin prescription.



GET YOUR INSULIN

If you qualify for the urgent need program, you can receive your insulin immediately, but you will need to pay up to a \$35 co-pay to receive your 30-day supply.
